FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

It's been two years since we introduced our Newsletter, "UCPS Chronicles" and its venture was remarkable in the past, with a smart set of editorial team of students and teachers working closely together. This year too, our new editorial team has taken over and I wish all the members a grand topical dawning.

I recently heard someone say 'Money is the root of all evil' and this time I stopped to ponder if it is really true all the time. Maybe not. One of the living legends according to me leading an exemplary life and the one whom I consider as a paragon is Mrs. Sudha Murty, the Chairperson of the Infosys foundation. If we take her example, the above saying is only a myth. Being the

wife of a billionaire business magnate, the amount of time and money she devotes to social work is commendable. She is a member of the Public Health Care initiatives of the Gates Foundation. She has founded several orphanages, participated in rural development efforts, supported the movement to support government schools with Computer and library facilities and established Murty Classical Library of India at Harvard University. She was awarded two of the highest civilian awards in India, the Padma Shri in 2006 and the Padma Bhushan in 2023.

Another great personality whom I admire is Ratan Tata, the great industrialist and former chairman of Tata Sons and Tata group. Mr. Tata is also one of the largest philanthropists in the world, having donated around 60-65% of his income to charity. In 2008, he received the Padma Vibhushan, the

second highest civilian honour in India, after receiving the Padma Bhushan, the third highest civilian honour in 2000.

I adore Mrs. Sudha and Mr. Tata for their simplicity and humility and even more for the greatest philanthropists that they are. However, as recorded in the Bible through the parable of the widow, the value of what we give is not based on the amount that is given but the willingness and involvement of the giver. There is scope to share our income to the needy, even if it's not in the millions as in the above examples. All of us can't be a Sudha Murty or Ratan Tata but we can encourage children to keep a portion of their earnings, especially their pocket money for charity. As adults, we should teach children the value of money and how to earn it with hard work and how it should be spent judiciously.

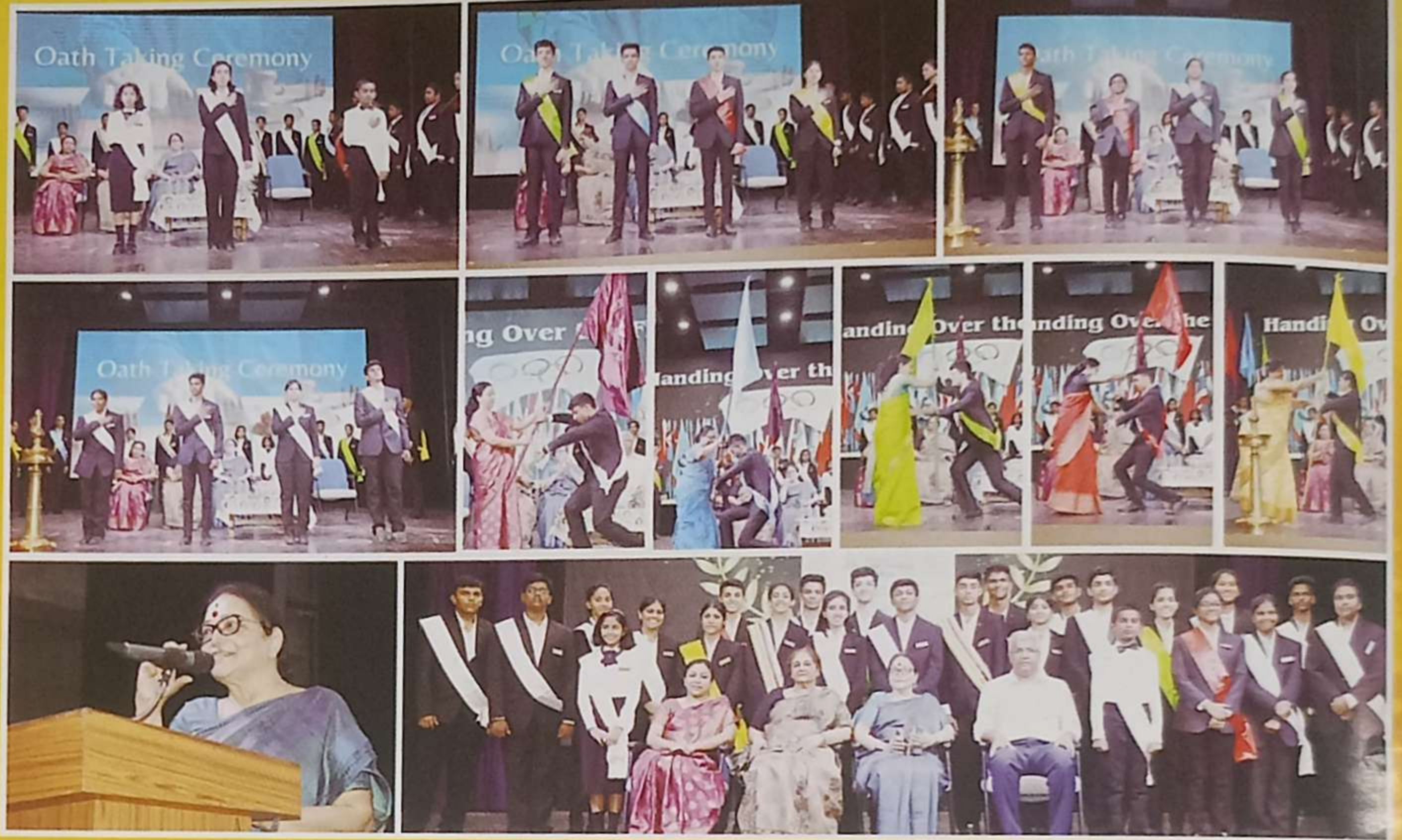

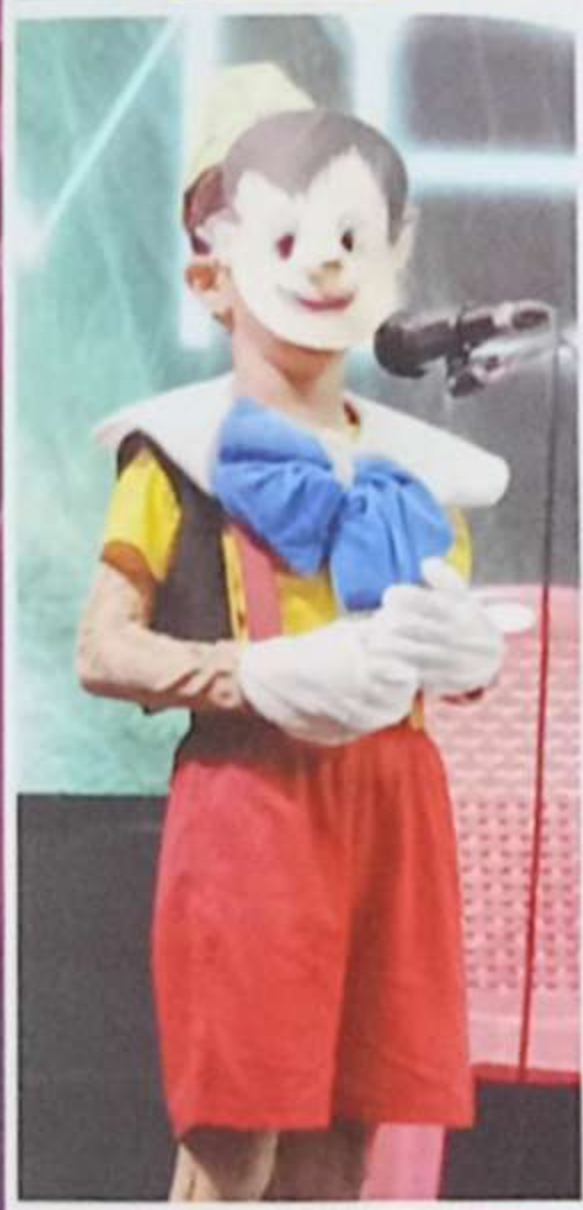
The event solemnly started with a prayer, after which our beloved

PROSPECTS OF LEGAL STUDIES (CAREER GUIDANCE)

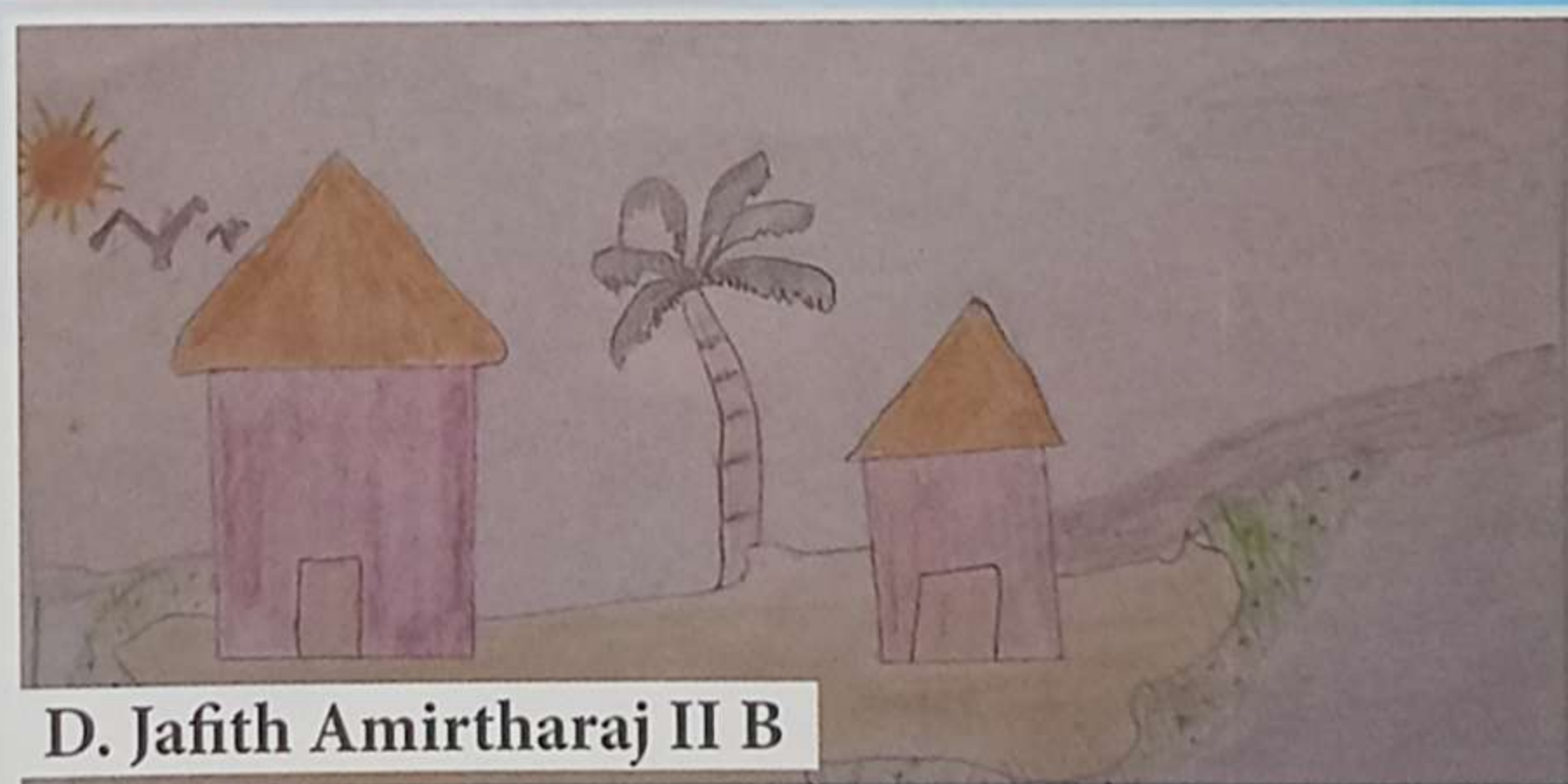

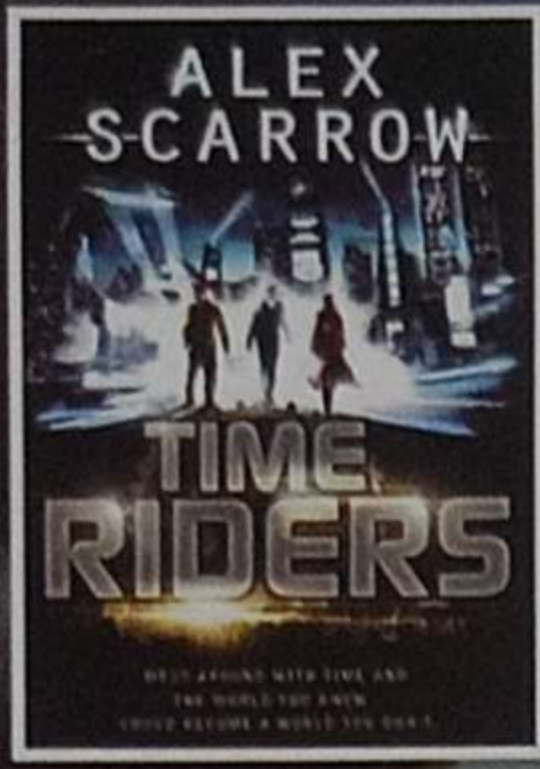
Be authentically Be 'you' tiful

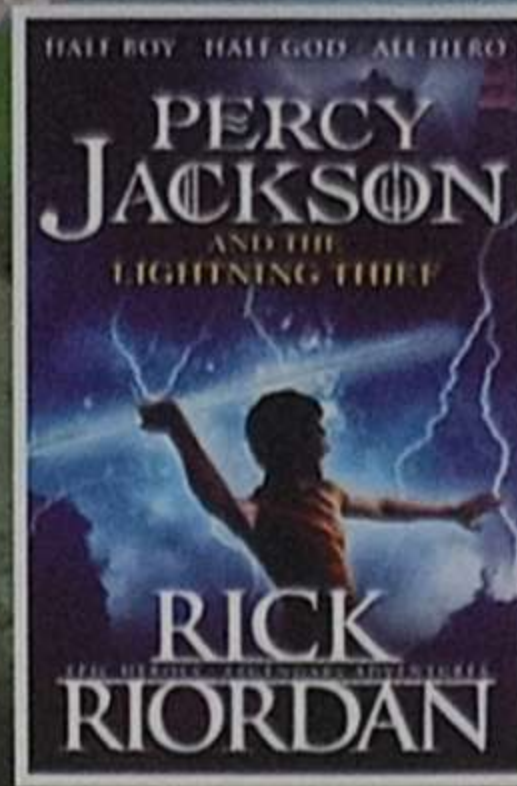

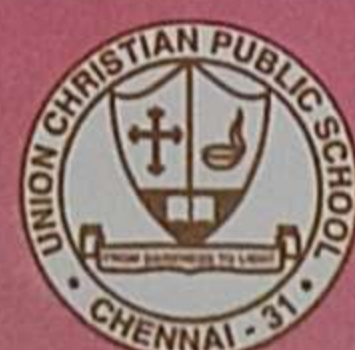
